as to develop a combination of Movement, Ball and Racket Skills. The key components of the programme are music and pictures; the music provides the rhythm and timing for the different Teddy Tennis games and exercises, the pictures are used to show the children how to play the combination works

brilliantly. Teddy Tennis will develop each Cub Cadet's athletic capabilities, improve their co-ordination, grow their confidence, enhance their communication skills and encourage them to come back for moreFUN!

Tennis Racquets

We have found that it surprises parents that rackets are only used in some of the Teddy Tennis activities and games. This is because Teddy Tennis is about developing an all round athletic capability with a focus on tennis. It is not just about teaching children how to use a tennis racket!

Head Ted will provide all the equipment necessary to play Teddy Tennis but we would recommend that you purchase a racket for practice at home. We supply custom designed, lightweight rackets which are perfect for budding Cub Cadets.
